Les Enluminures is delighted to return Frieze Masters London for the 2023 edition, following its successful participation since 2015 and hot on the heels of the gallery's presence at Frieze Masters Seoul in September. For this important occasion, we will bring together a curated selection of spectacular illuminated manuscripts, leaves, and jewelry from the Middle Ages and Renaissance.

We are thrilled to debut **the remarkable and beautiful Gilchrist Clark Psalter**. Belonging to a group of important Liege manuscripts, this beautiful thirteenth century Psalter contains a spectacular and unique Calendar displaying large-scale figures engaged in the Labors of the Months, painted in thick gold leaf directly on the blank parchment.

Another highlight manuscript is a rare example of a richly illustrated copy of one of the most important treatises on surgery from the Middle Ages, William of Saliceto's Chirurgia, here in an Italian translation known in only one other copy. The lively drawings, all carefully colored, function as real illustrations of the content of the text itself. The earliest owner has left his name in the volume, as well as personal notes. This book, still in its original blind-stamped leather binding, was surely a treasured possession, reflecting his wealth and status in his community.

Amongst a sparkling selection of important and wearable historic jewelry, we will exhibit an important piece from fifteenth century England. Of exceptional rarity and wholly authentic, the chain (or necklace or Livery Collar) is one of few surviving from the period. We find similar chains in paintings of the time, and a few exist in major European museums. Similar chains signify loyalty to a sovereign (such as the SS-chains) or affiliation with a chivalric order (such as the Order of the Golden Fleece). The letters on our example—which can be read either as S + M or M+ S may refer to the names of a couple and the union of their two houses or it could be an abbreviation for a prayer such as "Sancte Maria."

Founded by Dr. Sandra Hindman more than thirty years ago and with locations in Paris, Chicago, and New York, Les Enluminures has forged long-standing relationships with major museums and prestigious private collections throughout the world. It exhibits at TEFAF Maastricht, Frieze Masters, and the Winter Show. The gallery is well-known for the level of its scholarship but also for the diversity, high quality, and provenance of the works it offers for sale.
